

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PUBLIC AUCTIONS FOR THE DISPOSAL OF ASSETS OF SANTA CASA DA MISERICÓRDIA DE LISBOA

1. Data controller

The data controller is Santa Casa da Misericórdia de Lisboa (SCML), a private-law legal entity of administrative public utility, with corporate tax number 500 745 471 and registered office at Largo Trindade Coelho, 1200-470 LISBON.

2. Purpose of processing and legal basis

The personal data processed in the context of subscribing to and receiving information about public auctions are your name, email address and your location (e.g. Portugal), which will be known by SCML/DGIP (Departamento de Gestão Imobiliária e Património).

The legal basis for the processing of personal data is your free, specific, informed and unambiguous consent. By consenting to the processing of personal data, you express your agreement and authorisation for your personal data to be used in this context.

3. Personal data retention periods

Personal data is processed in strict compliance with the applicable legislation, being stored for a period of 7 days after the request for cancellation of the subscription, with deletion as its final destination.

Your personal data is stored in our database for the purpose of public auction disclosure. If you wish to unsubscribe from our *newsletter*, you may do so by sending an email to hastapublica@scml.pt.

4. Rights of the data subject and contact details of the Data Protection Officer

Under Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, as well as Law no. 58/2019 of 8 August, the data subject is guaranteed the right of information, access, rectification, portability, restriction of processing, objection or erasure of their personal data, as well as the right to withdraw consent at any time, without compromising the lawfulness of processing carried out in the meantime, and subject to the conditions provided for by law.
